HOLYOKE -- The three-day **Next Stop: Holyoke** festival is happening now.

Art, food, music, history, cultural and sporting events began Friday (Oct. 10) and will continue through Sunday at sites around the city.

From 2 to 9 p.m. on Sunday, the "Viva Great Holyoke Block Party" closes out the weekend in front of City Hall at High and Dwight streets with a car show and rock, reggae and Latin bands.

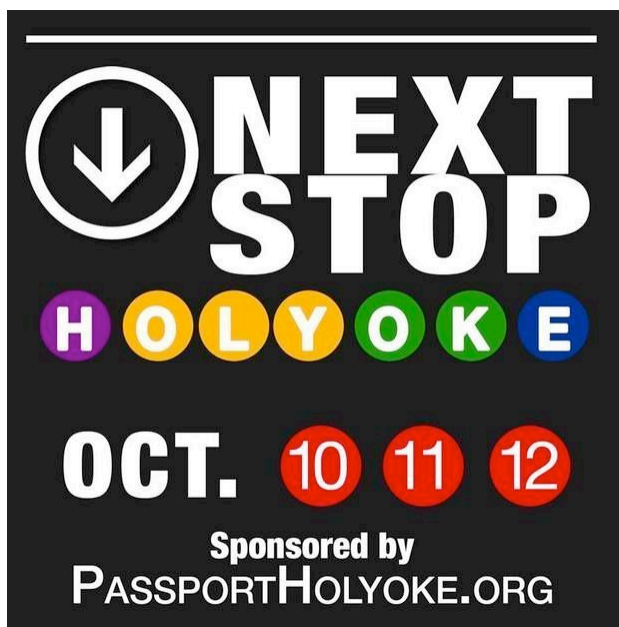
