We are pleased to inform you that your request for funds for the Victory Theatre Project has been fully approved. On March 13, 2019, the Community Preservation Act Committee (CPAC) voted to recommend the award of the full requested amount of \$100,000. This vote was subsequently approved by the City Council on April 2, 2019. These funds are to be used for the restoration of the theatre's 63 light fixtures, provided that MIFA meet all the conditions required in a forthcoming contract with the City of Holyoke via the Community Preservation Act Committee.

We are proud to be part of this project and to support the City's goal of historic preservation, specifically with regards to the restoration of the historic Victory Theatre, an iconic building with tremendous promise for enriching Holyoke's cultural offerings.
